## **Activity: Assurances and Prerequisites**

for Significantly Disproportionate LEAs

### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Assurances and Prerequisites Activity is to provide information on significant disproportionality, the federal and state requirements and guidance, and the supports provided to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) in California.

### **Instructions**

1. Required Completion of Assurances Form:

This document, which will be sent via email to each LEA by the CDE, must be completed and submitted to sigdisp@cde.ca.gov no later than 30 days after the receipt of the Annual Determination Letter. This document outlines the requirements for the LEAs who are significantly disproportionate, including the 15% budget set-aside obligation of the LEA.
