Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Resource Map

The purpose of this resource map is to provide a list of high-leverage resources from the California System of Support (SOS) providers on educational services for students with IEPs, aged 6-21 and aged 3-5, Least Restrictive Environment (LRE).

Why did we create this resource map?

Many Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) and charter schools that are eligible for differentiated assistance (DA) are also required to write and implement the Compliance for Improvement Monitoring (CIM) Plan for Special Education. To support California's One System of Support, this resource map is designed to identify existing resources targeted for LRE to be accessed by educators in both general education and special education settings.

Indicator 5: Least Restrictive Environment – Percent of children with IEPs, aged 6 through 21, served:

- A. Inside the regular class 80 percent or more of the day;
- B. Inside the regular class less than 40 percent of the day; and
- C. In separate schools, residential facilities, or homebound/hospital placements. (20 *USC* 1416(a)(3)(A))

Indicator 6: Pre-School Least Restrictive Environment – Percent of children with IEPs, aged 3 through 5, served:

- A. Inside the preschool: Regular Setting
- B. In a separate setting
- C. Home Setting

Supplemental supports are provided in addition to, not in place of universal supports, and available to all students regardless of identification for specialized services based on need through the use of diagnostic and progress monitoring assessments.





INTENSIFIED SUPPORT

Targeted supports are provided to students with greater needs to support academic, behavior, social-emotional, and/or mental health through the integration and implementation of Universal Design for Learning and differentiated instruction. Intensified supports are provided in addition to, not in place of universal supports, via specialized service providers, and available to all students regardless of identification for specialized services based on need through the use of diagnostic and progress monitoring assessments.

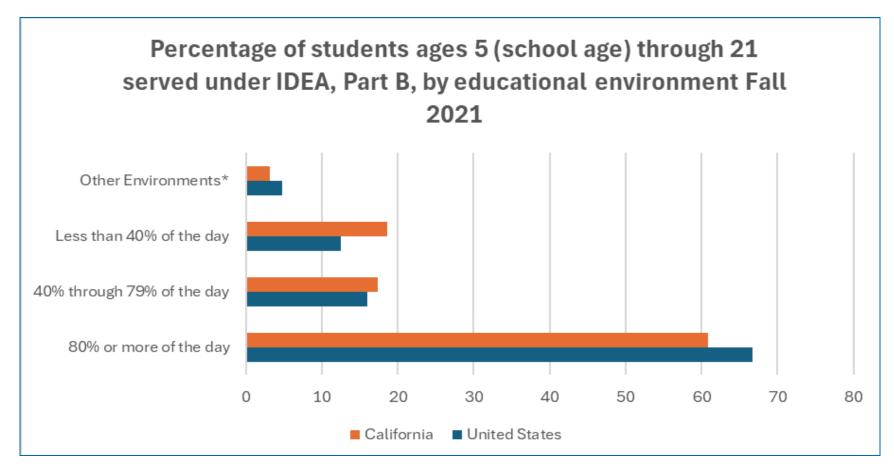

Multi-Tiered System of Supports-MTSS, represents a comprehensive approach aimed at ensuring the success of all students by providing a framework of supports, services, and interventions. It's designed to address a spectrum of needs, spanning academic, behavioral, and social/emotional domains. Within this framework, various components such as problem-solving data teams, Response to Intervention (RTI), Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), as well as social-emotional and mental health supports, play crucial roles.

In California, the MTSS framework is structured around the principle of providing universal support for all students, acknowledging that while the majority of students will thrive with this level of support, some may require additional assistance periodically, and a few may need more intensive support intermittently. The goal is to create and maintain an inclusive and equitable learning environment where every student can succeed alongside their grade-level peers.

By embracing MTSS, educators can continually evolve their approaches and strategies, ensuring they are equipped to meet the diverse needs of their student population effectively. This proactive and systematic approach not only fosters academic growth but also supports the holistic development of each student, promoting their overall well-being and success in school.



^{*}United States-Other environments consist of separate schools (2.4 percent), parentally placed in private schools (1.7 percent), homebound/hospital (0.4 percent), residential facility (0.2 percent), and correctional facilities (0.1 percent). California -Other environments separate school (2.2); parentally placed (0.5); Home/hospital (0.3); (residential; (0.1); correctional facilities (.01). Children with disabilities who are parentally placed in private schools may be educated to varying degrees, including the majority of the day, with their peers without disabilities.
