CIM Step 2 At-A-Glance

The CIM Process



Purpose

LEAs identify problem areas, uncover root causes, examine current initiatives addressing those causes, and pinpoint any existing gaps.

Step 2 Activities:

Step 2 includes activities to help Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) analyze data and collaboratively determine root causes of challenges. **The specific activities that LEAs need to complete are based on their individual monitoring status.**

Examples of **some** of the activities are listed below:

- **Root Cause Analysis:** A process to uncover the deepest underlying causes of a problem, that if dissolved, would eliminate or substantially reduce the problem area.
- **Initiative Inventory:** Review current and past initiatives to identify strategies that address root causes and gaps in efforts.
- **Prioritization:** Determine which problem areas to address first based on urgency, importance, and potential impact.
- **Theory of Action:** Identify which strategies the LEA will use to address the problem area(s) they have prioritized and the expected outcome.
