### **The CIM Process**

Step 1
Gather and Inquire

Step 2
Investigate

Step 3
Plan
Implementation

#### **Purpose**

Implement the LEA's Plan for Improvement and achieve improved outcomes by implementing the plan for over a two year period of time.

### **Step 4 Activities:**

Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) engage in ongoing monitoring and evaluation of the improvement plan to assess progress, make necessary adjustments, and improve outcomes for students. **The specific activities that LEAs need to complete are based on their individual monitoring status.** 

Examples of **some** of the activities are listed below:

- Meet Regularly as a CIM Team: Convene the CIM team on a regular basis.
- Implement High Leverage Strategies: Implement strategies outlined in the Plan for Improvement.
- Monitor Progress: Collect and review data regularly to measure progress towards goals and outcomes outlined in the Improvement Plan.
- Adjust as Needed: Use progress data to make adjustments to strategies ensuring ongoing alignment with improvement goals.
- Submit Progress Reports: Prepare and submit progress reports at required intervals.
