Small local education agencies (LEAs) identified as Disproportionate in the 2025 Annual Determination Letter (ADL) will participate in the following Dispro-S Year 1 activities:

- 1. Data Quality Toolkit (DQT) Self-Assessment
- 2. Policy & Procedure Review (PPR)

DQT Self-Assessment Activity

The purpose of the DQT Self-Assessment is to determine if there are any concerns with data quality. LEAs should complete the following steps to complete the DQT Self-Assessment:

- ☐ Review the DQT Self-Assessment Instructions
- ☐ Complete the DQT Self-Assessment for all three domains:
 - Data Governance
 - o System Design and Development
 - o Data Use
- **Submit** the "Journal" file to <u>SmallMonitoring@cde.ca.gov</u> using the following naming convention:
 - a. 2025 LEA NAME_DisproY1_DQT.pdf

Policy and Procedure Review (PPR)

The purpose of the PPR is to help LEAs determine compliance with state and federal regulations which will help the LEA determine programming gaps that may be impacting student outcomes. LEAs should complete the following steps to complete the PPR:

Watch the PPR in SECMS-S Training Video.
Review the PPR Instructions.
Access the PPR in the Special Education Compliance Monitoring System for Small LEAs
(SECMS-S) using the login information from the CDE.
Review the LEA's policies and procedures to determine compliance using the PPR
Protocol.
Input Findings into SECMS-S using the PPR Instructions.
Submit the 'Initial Review' once completed.
o If the LEA has a Student Record Review listed in SECMS-S as well, do not submit

until all reviews in SECMS-S have been completed.
