



## **Targeted Monitoring – 2025 Monitoring Year 2025 CIM Cohort – Targeted Levels 1 and 2**

# CIM Step 1–Gather and Inquire: Parent Input (required for Levels 1 and 2 if Indicator 8 is unmet)

### **Description**

Parent Input is a required CIM Step 1 activity for any Targeted Level 1 or 2 LEA that did not meet the statewide target on Element/Indicator 8—Parent Involvement. The LEA's data for identifying its monitoring designation is accessible at <a href="mailto:caltan.info/monitoring">caltan.info/monitoring</a>, and it will show whether the target for Element/Indicator 8 was met or unmet.

Seeds of Partnership, a third-party vendor, offers an optional method for obtaining parent input using Registration Form Link and Parent Input System Admin Site. Whichever method of collecting parent input the LEA uses, it must include input from parents of students with IEPs and address unmet Indicators/Elements and other identified issues pertinent to that target group.

#### **LEA Required Tasks**

### Participating Targeted Level 1 and 2 LEAs

- Obtain input from parents of students with special needs, addressing unmet Indicators/Elements and other identified issues pertinent to that target group.
- Create a Parent Input activity summary that includes the following:
  - A description of the target group, which must include parents of students with special needs
  - o Identification of the tools, sources, and/or methodologies used
  - A summary of findings, including...
    - Participation numbers or rates
    - Patterns or trends observed among responses
    - New information learned

- Areas that need to be addressed.
- Provide the Parent Input activity summary to the SELPA by **July 10, 2025**.
