



Targeted Monitoring – 2025 Monitoring Year 2025 CIM Cohort – Targeted Level 3

CIM Step 1–Gather and Inquire: Parent Input (required for Level 3 or if Indicator 8 is unmet)

Description

Parent Input is a required CIM Step 1 activity for all Targeted Level 3 LEAs. The LEA's data for identifying its monitoring designation is accessible at caltan.info/monitoring, and it will show whether the target for Element/Indicator 8 was met or unmet.

Seeds of Partnership, a third-party vendor, offers an optional method for obtaining parent input using <u>Registration Form Link</u> and <u>Parent Input System Admin Site</u>. Whichever method of collecting parent input the LEA uses, it must include input from parents of students with IEPs and address unmet Indicators/Elements and other identified issues pertinent to that target group.

LEA Required Tasks

Targeted Level 3 LEAs

- Obtain input from parents of students with special needs, addressing unmet Indicators/Elements and other identified issues pertinent to that target group.
- Create a Parent Input activity summary.
- Document completion of the Parent Input activity by entering the required information into the Parent Input box in Stepwell, shown below. Submit to the CDE via Stepwell by July 10, 2025.
