

Theory of Action

Activity: Theory of Action

Purpose

The Theory of Action identifies which strategies the LEA will use to address the problem area(s) they have prioritized and the expected outcomes. It is a statement that distills all of the CIM work from Step 1 and Step 2 and the activities to be planned and implemented in Step 3 and Step 4.

Instructions

- **1. Review:** (Theory of Action is a required activity for Intensive LEAs and an optional activity for Targeted LEAs): The CIM team should begin the activity by reviewing the resource, <u>Driver Diagram</u>.
- 2. Create a Shared Theory of Action:
 - a) Option 1: Create a theoretical statement that will guide the work of the CIM team moving forward. The Theory of Action is a statement that identifies which strategies the LEA will use to address the problem area(s) and the expected outcomes. It is a statement that distills all of the CIM work from Step 1 and Step 2 and the activities to be planned and implemented in Step 3 and Step 4. Use the sentence frame: If we...then....which will result in...
 - **b)** Option 2: Review the <u>Driver Diagram Instructions</u> and use the <u>Driver Diagram (Blank)</u> document to create a shared theory of action. Document the team's:
 - i. Overall goal
 - ii. High Leverage Strategies
 - iii. Activities
- **3. Document:** Document the team's Theory of Action.
