2024 Compliance and Improvement Monitoring (CIM) Process Targeted Assurances for Special Education Local Plan Areas (SELPAs)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

General Information

When will we receive the SELPA Assurances and Certifications 2024 form?

The SELPA Assurances and Certifications 2024 form will be provided within the next month.

Is this for Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) new to the CIM Process?

The Targeted Assurances form is to be used for Targeted Level 1 and 2 LEAs who are working on Steps 1-3 and LEAs implementing a current CIM plan.

For LEAs that have transitioned from Targeted Level 2 to Targeted Level 3, is this process required?

No, Assurances forms are not required for Targeted Level 3 LEAs. LEAs that are currently in Targeted Level 3, as indicated in their 2024 Annual Determination Letter (ADL), will submit all CIM activities to the California Department of Education (CDE).

Does the SELPA need to complete Assurances for Indicator 8 for Targeted Level 1 LEAs?

SELPA will complete Assurances for Targeted Level 1 and 2 LEAs who are developing a plan. If the LEA did not meet Indicator 8, then the SELPA needs to verify the LEA completed the Parent Input activity.

Are Targeted Level 1 LEAs required to complete progress reports?

If the LEA is in Targeted Level 1, they are required to self-monitor. However, some SELPAs are requiring LEAs to complete progress reports.

Are SELPA Assurances required for Small LEAs Cycle B?

SELPA Assurances are not required for Small LEAs Cycle B.

What should be included in the comments section?

CIM Process

What is the best way to determine the monitoring level for LEAs?

Does the ADL indicate the CIM Process status of the LEA?

For LEAs that have transitioned from Targeted Level 3 to Targeted Level 2, do the LEAs continue to work on the same plan or restart the CIM Process?

The LEA should continue to implement the plan previously developed.

Which Targeted Level LEAs are required to develop a CIM Plan?

All Targeted Level 1-3 LEAs must develop a CIM Plan.

Are teachers required to be on the CIM Team?

Teachers are not required CIM Team members, but the LEA may add members that are not required.

If a Targeted Level 1 LEA did not meet the target for Indicator 8, does the Parent Input activity need to be completed?

Yes.

When is the due date for CIM Step 2?

October 10, 2024.

When is the CIM Step 3 training?

The CIM Step 3 Training will be held on October 16, 2024, at 10:00 am.
