



When to Use:

When the team has identified a focus area for their improvement work and is ready to create an initial theory of improvement. The team should update its Driver Diagram regularly to reflect ongoing learning.

Elements:

- 1. The overall goal clearly defines success for the improvement effort, focuses change efforts and motivates collective action.
- 2. High leverage strategies are "what" needs to change in the system (key structures, processes, and norms) in order to achieve the aim.
- 3. Activities are concrete and specific actions of "how" the system will be changed.

How to Create:

- 1. Develop and articulate an overall goal
- 2. Option 1: Move left to right
 - \circ Identify high leverage strategies that need to be addressed to achieve the overall goal
 - o Identify activities that influence the high leverage strategies
- 3. Option 2: Move right to left
 - o Identify activities.
 - o Affinitize based on commonalities in which high leverage strategies these activities address
